

District/International Matching Scholarship Program Michael Brukwicki Jr. Memorial Leadership Scholarship Information Sheet



The \$1,000 Michael Brukwicki Jr. Memorial Leadership Scholarship is made possible by donations from the WIUM Key Club District and the Wisconsin-Upper Michigan District Kiwanis. The recipient(s) will be named at the annual District Leadership Conference. The check will be mailed to the recipient's school and be made payable to the recipient and his/her chosen college or university prior to December 31st of the current fiscal year.

PURPOSE

The leadership scholarship will be awarded annually to a Key Clubber who has exemplified to the highest degree, the basic principles of Key Club caring and sharing in their home, school, and community. The recipient will be of high moral character, and should have achieved excellence in all their endeavors.

QUALIFICATIONS

1. Applicant must be an active member in good standing in the Wisconsin-Upper Michigan Key Club District, and must have been a member for at least two years.
2. Applicant must be a graduating senior in a Wisconsin-Upper Michigan high school.
3. Applicant must be a college, university, or technical school bound student.
4. Financial need will NOT be a factor in the decision.
5. Grade point average of applicant must be at least a "B" average or the equivalent to a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.

REQUIREMENTS/ATTACHMENTS

Below are additional required items that must be attached to the application. Use a separate page for each item, with the page labeled as to what section it pertains to.

1. Section 1 - Provide a list of high school extracurricular activities to which you have contributed (clubs, sports, etc. if applicable). Specify any pertinent details.
2. Section 2 - Provide a list of outside activities to which you have contributed (scouting, volunteer organizations, church/community activities, etc., if applicable). Specify any pertinent details.
3. Section 3 - Provide a list of honors, awards, and/or special recognitions received in the past four years (both in and out of school, if applicable).
4. Section 4 - Provide a list of the Key Club offices/positions you've held in the past two years (if applicable).
5. Section 5 - Write a one-page essay (typed, single spaced) on your involvement and leadership experience in Key Club.
6. Section 6 - Provide a total of three (3) letters of recommendation (one from each of the following sectors). Letters shall be one page, signed, dated, and from individuals not related to the applicant. They should cover service to school, community, Key Club, leadership ability, scholarship, personality, and integrity.
 - A Kiwanian
 - A School Official
 - A Responsible Community or Church Leader
7. Section 7 - Attach an Official High School Transcript.
