

**OUTSTANDING DIVISIONAL UNITY AWARD**  
**WISCONSIN-UPPER MICHIGAN DISTRICT, KEY CLUB INTERNATIONAL**

This award honors a division in the WI-UM District that demonstrates exceptional unity and spirit through service, fellowship, and leadership.

**Part 1: Criteria**

- Your division must have strong communicative ties between the clubs within your division, the club's advisors, the Kiwanis Family Members, and your Lieutenant Governor.
  
- Demonstrate your Division's unity between **April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 and January 20, 2020** by participating in interclub service events and attending Divisional Council Meetings

**Part 2: Application Requirements**

1. The **Lieutenant Governor** of your Division must write a 2-page essay, (double spaced) answering **at least three** of the following questions:
  - a. How was unity built among the clubs in your division?
  - b. How did your clubs communicate to remain unified?
  - c. What issues did you face in keeping the clubs in your division unified?
  - d. How were you able to use the divisional Facebook page to your advantage?
  
2. The **Lieutenant Governor** must create a list of events hosted in your division that promoted unification. Please include a brief explanation to how each of these events promoted unification. For example: divisional projects, interclub meetings, (not including the required Divisional Council Meetings).
  
3. At least one **president** of a club in your division must type a 2-page essay, (double spaced) answering **at least three** of the following questions:
  - a. How did the Lieutenant Governor of your division promote unification?
  - b. To what extent did the other clubs in your division participate in divisional projects created by your Lieutenant Governor?
  - c. What use did the divisional Facebook page have to you and your club members in terms of promoting unification within your division?
  - d. What do you think are the benefits of having a unified division?
  
4. The **Lieutenant Governor** needs to provide at least three other items for consideration. For example: a divisional point system, agenda/attendance sheets for meetings (not including the four required Divisional Council Meetings, copies of tweets promoting interclub events, etc.
  
5. The **Lieutenant Governor** must fill out and attach the form found on page 2 of this document.
