Collect non-perishable can goods and old clothes and donate them to place like a woman's shelter or The Salvation Army. Get in touch with businesses to see if you can get them involved too!



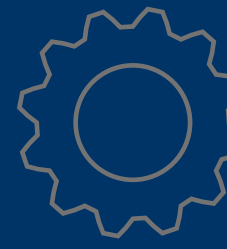
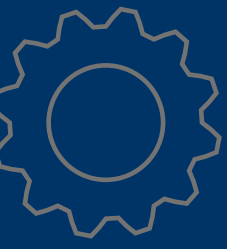


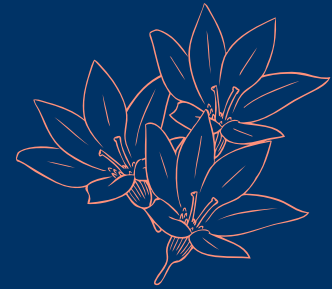
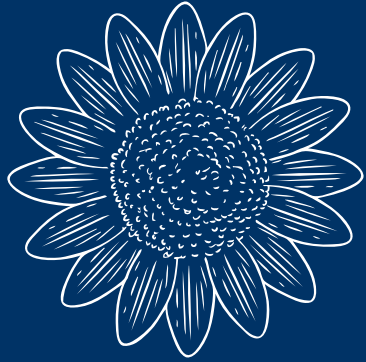
As For Organizing...
